Why do I need to reinstall my laptop battery driver?

Your laptop battery communicates with the Windows system through the Microsoft ACPI-Compliant Control Method Battery driver, making it a critical driver to work properly. However, you might need to reinstall or update your battery driver sometimes for some reason.

How to reinstall battery driver?

The first method to reinstall your battery driver is to uninstall it via the Device Manager. Restarting your PC will reinstall the driver automatically. 2. Use a dedicated tool

How do I reinstall a battery in Windows 10?

Right-click the Start Menu and select Device Manager. Expand the Batteries category. Right-click on each battery device (if there are multiple), and select Uninstall Device. Restart your PC, and Windows will reinstall the driver. Retest to see if your issue has been resolved. Solution: Replace the battery.
