How long is a car battery warranty?

Most manufacturers offer a warranty of around 36 months as standard. Some high-performance batteries may provide warranties extending to 60 months or more. Car battery warranties often vary based on the type of battery. For instance, traditional lead-acid batteries usually come with a warranty of three years.

If the battery isn't functioning at its full capacity, its range will start to decrease, requiring the driver to recharge it more frequently. Without a car warranty, EV batteries are very expensive to repair or replace, so having battery coverage for long enough to cover most of a battery's lifespan is imperative.

10-year limited product warranty (materials and labour). 25-year limited power warranty (typically 10 years at 90% power output and 25 years at 80% power output). As you can see, manufacturers typically offer a 7 or 8-year warranty for their EV batteries (or around 100,000 miles, whichever comes sooner). Be sure to check with the ...

In that case, the warranty is valid until the battery stores and delivers 30 MWh-or 30,000 kilowatt-hours (kWh)-of energy. Like a cycle life warranty, throughput warranties typically only apply if your battery delivers a set amount of energy before its warranty period.

All electric vehicle batteries degrade over time and become less efficient, much like any other battery, however this is certainly minimal.
