What does a battery warranty cover?

The battery warranty covers defects in materials and workmanship that result in excessive capacity loss over the warranty period. It does not cover damage caused by accidents, misuse, or environmental factors. How long is the battery warranty? The length of the battery warranty varies depending on the model of the vehicle.

What is a battery degradation warranty?

This warranty covers battery capacity loss over time and use and is only available for certain models and years. For example, the Model S and Model X from 2012 to 2015 have an 8-year Battery Degradation Warranty, while the Model S and Model X from 2016 onward have a 5-year Battery Degradation Warranty.

Will Tesla replace a battery pack if I don't have a warranty?

Tesla will also replace a battery pack that loses more than 30% of its range within the vehicle's warranty period. A final note on Tesla warranties: opening or servicing the battery compartment without a Tesla certification will void your Tesla's battery warranty.
