

How do I drain my phone battery fast?

The fastest way to drain your phone battery is to turn on the flashlight. Disable automatic screen lock and boost your screen's brightness to the maximum. You can also use graphically intensive apps and games, launch lots of apps that use your location, and enable sounds and vibrations. Turn on your flashlight.

How do I turn off my screen while on battery power?

Under the "Power" section, click the Screen and sleep setting. Reduce the number of minutes before turning off the display while on battery power using the "On battery power, turn off my screen after" setting. After you complete the steps, the display will automatically turn off when you specify to save power.

How do I Turn on power mode?

Open Settings. Click on System. Click the Power & battery page on the right side. Quick tip: If the device is not connected to a battery, the page will appear as "Power." Click the Power Mode setting. Best Power Efficiency: This option preserves the most energy while lowering the system's performance.

How do I turn off a battery?

Open Control Panel. Click on Hardware and Sound. Click on Power Options. Click the "Choose what closing the lid does" option in the left pane. Under the "On battery" section, use the "When I close the lid" setting and choose the Sleep or Hibernate (recommended) option.
