How to calculate battery efficiency?

The following steps outline how to calculate the Battery Efficiency. First, determine the energy density of discharge. Next, determine the energy density of charge. Next, gather the formula from above = $BE = EDD / EDC * 100$. Finally, calculate the Battery Efficiency.

How to calculate battery pack capacity?

The battery pack capacity C_{bp} [Ah] is calculated as the product between the number of strings N_{sb} [-] and the capacity of the battery cell C_{bc} [Ah]. The total number of cells of the battery pack N_{cb} [-] is calculated as the product between the number of strings N_{sb} [-] and the number of cells in a string N_{cs} [-].

For this example we'll design the high voltage battery pack for a vehicle range of 250 km. The following calculations are going to be performed for each cell type.

How do you calculate the number of cells in a battery pack?

The total number of cells of the battery pack N_{cb} [-] is calculated as the product between the number of strings N_{sb} [-] and the number of cells in a string N_{cs} [-]. The size and mass of the high voltage battery are very important parameter to consider when designing a battery electric vehicle (BEV).

How do you calculate the total number of strings in a battery pack?

The total number of strings of the battery pack N_{sb} [-] is calculated by dividing the battery pack total energy E_{bp} [Wh] to the energy content of a string E_{bs} [Wh]. The number of strings must be an integer. Therefore, the result of the calculation is rounded to the higher integer.

The power output of the battery pack is equal to: $P_{pack} = I_{pack} \cdot U_{pack} = 43.4 \text{ W}$. The power loss of the battery pack is calculated as: $P_{loss} = R_{pack} \cdot I_{pack}^2 = 0.09 \cdot 4^2 = 1.44 \dots$

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formula to calculate the C rate is given by: [C Rate = $\frac{\text{Current of Charge or Discharge (A)}}{\text{Energy Rating (Ah)}}$]

When you charge and then discharge a battery cell you lose energy, the ratio of the amount of discharge to charge energy is the efficiency. If we put 11 Wh into a battery cell when charging and recover 10 Wh when discharging the energy efficiency = $10 / 11 = 90.9\%$

To charge a standard battery pack, the average cost is about \$2 per year with daily use. For larger batteries, like those in electric vehicles, costs range from \$9 to \$40 per full charge.
